

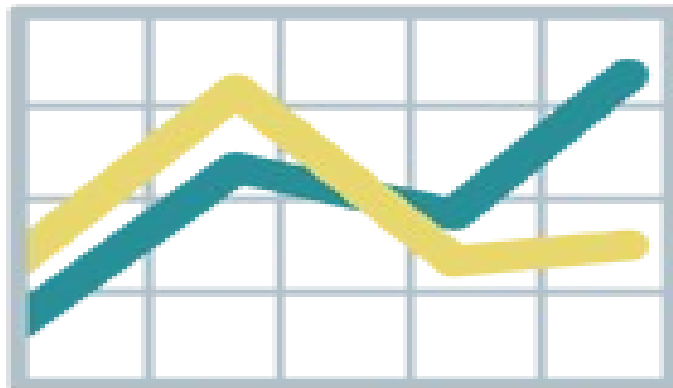

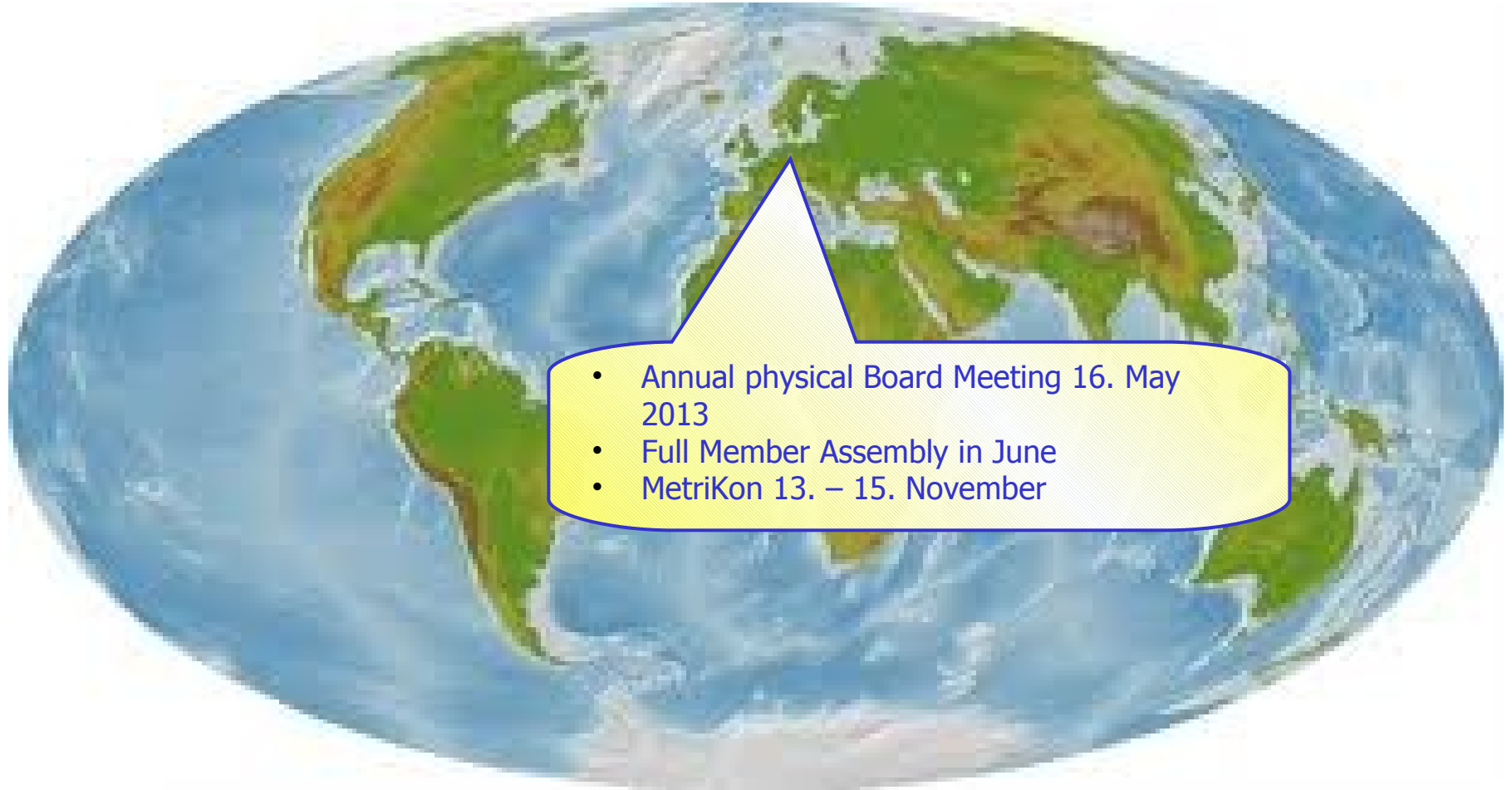

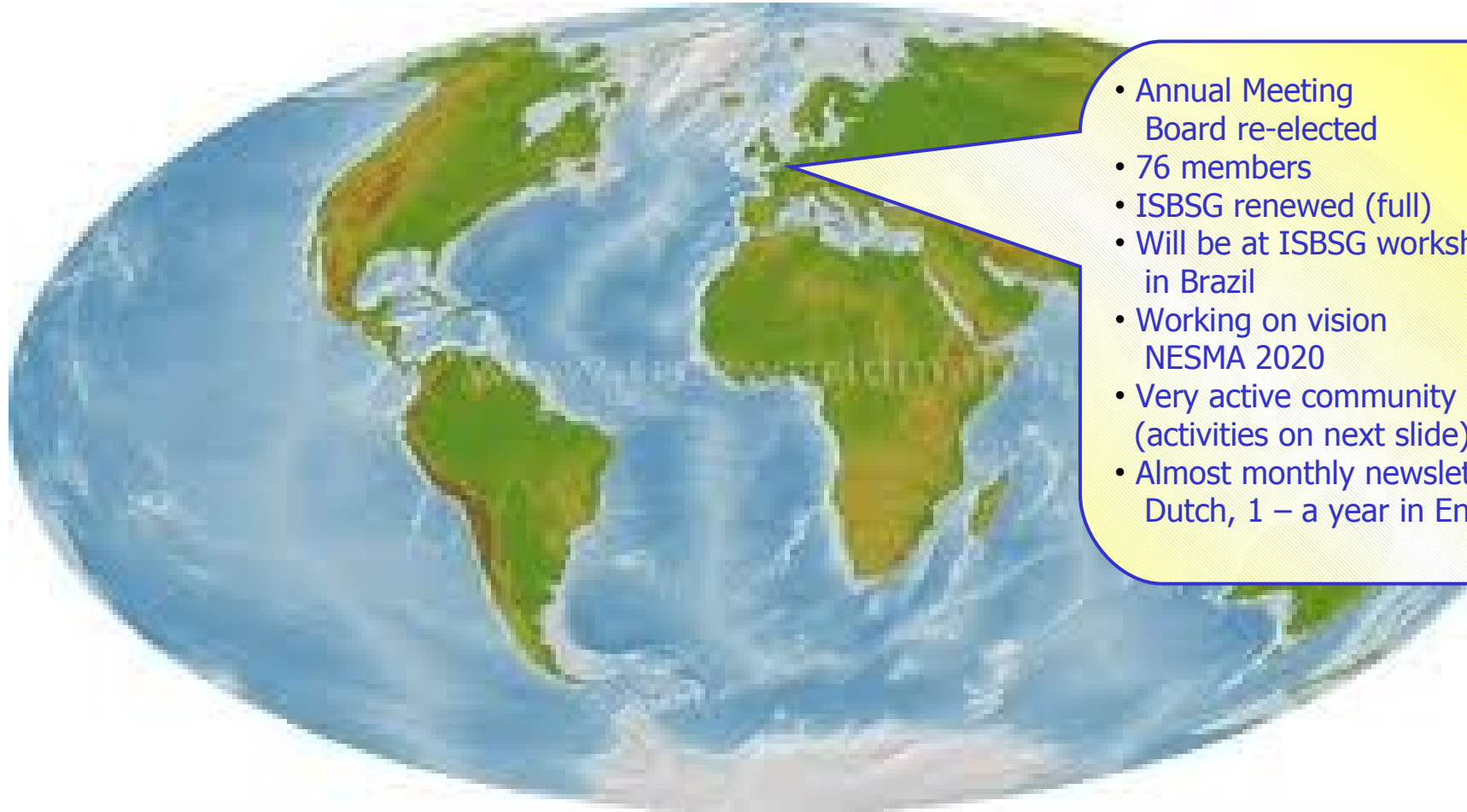
- Annual physical Board Meeting 16. May 2013

- FiSMA will be present in SPICE2013 conference early June and in EuroSPI2013 conference late June

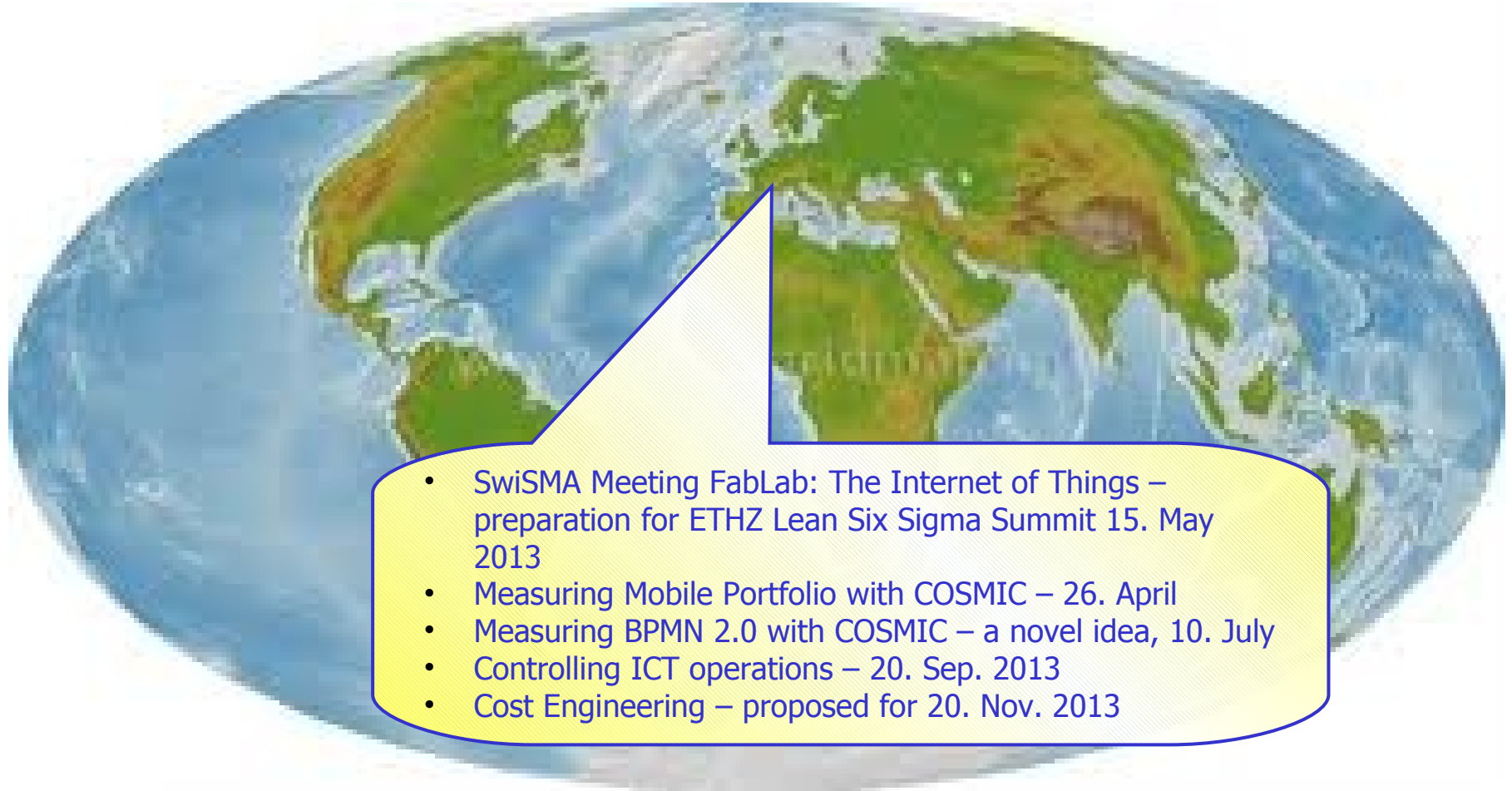
